- ² WR 227 is not required if students previously completed WR 123 at 3 credits or have completed WR 122 at 4 credits (inclusive of research writing), or have completed a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university in an English speaking country. It is *highly* recommended that all writing courses be completed prior to starting the nursing program.
