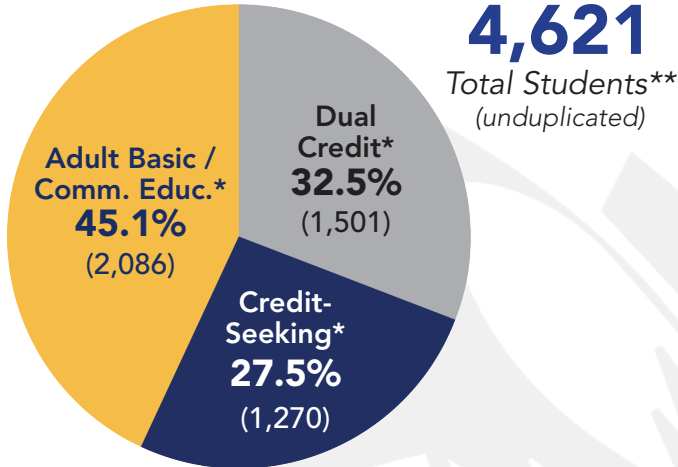
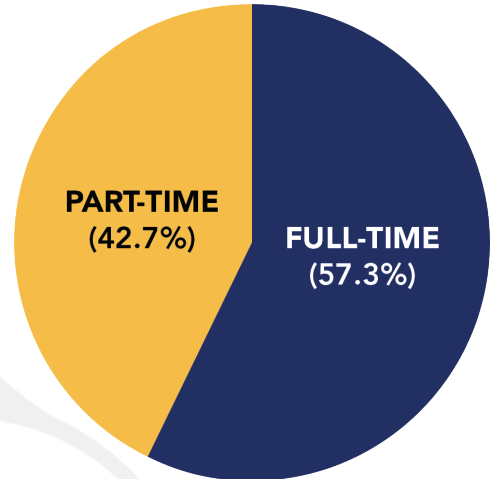

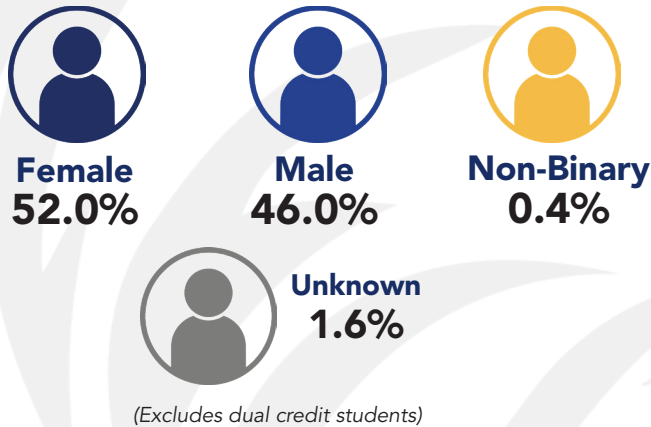

ENROLLMENT STATUS*

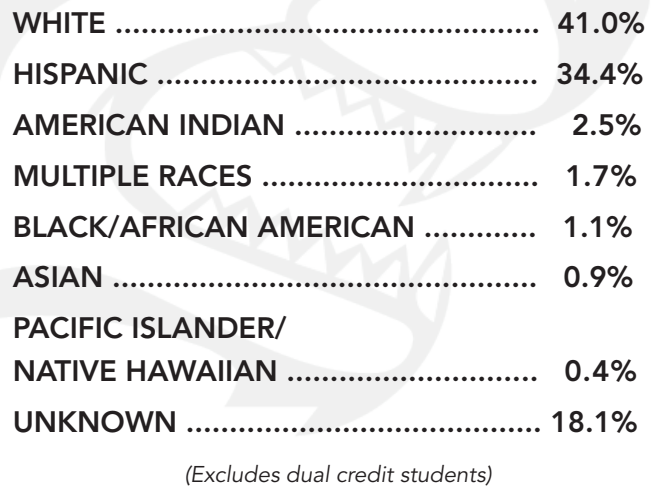

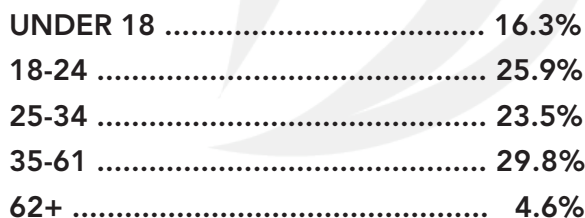
GENDER (self-reported)



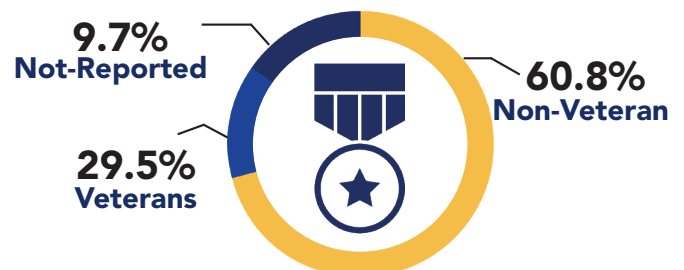
RACE/ETHNICITY (self-reported)

LOCATION (percent by county)

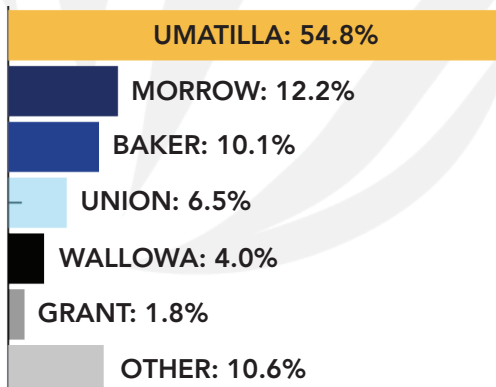
