Purpose/Principle/Definitions:

In order to clarify the role of Blue Mountain Community College in the region, the Board of Education, at the 26 January 2004 meeting, passed the following resolution which is hereby adopted as an Administrative Procedure of the college.

BLUE MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF EDUCATION RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Board of Education of Blue Mountain Community College (BMCC) recognizes and reaffirms the value of our role for the citizens of Northeastern Oregon, and;

Whereas, the Oregon Revised Statutes prescribe the breadth of services and education that BMCC and all Oregon Community Colleges will provide, and;

Whereas, Oregon Revised Statute 341.009 prescribes, in part, that BMCC and all community colleges in Oregon will provide transfer and professional-technical education, be within commuting time of a substantial majority of students and maintain a unique quality of flexibility, and;

Whereas, the Oregon Revised Statute 341.039 prescribes, in part, that Boards of Education of community college districts shall annually review district programs and services in order to determine which services can be most effectively and economically delivered directly and which should be contracted, and;

Whereas, the Board of Education of BMCC recognizes and supports definitions of primary and outlying centers established by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU); therefore

Be it resolved that the Board of Education of Blue Mountain Community College reaffirms that, while the administrative operation of BMCC predominantly occurs in Pendleton, the BMCC campus will encompass the entire service area of the college, including the areas served as contracted-out-of-district (COD), and;

Be it further resolved that the Board of Education of Blue Mountain Community College reaffirms that the intent of ORS 341.009 and ORS 341.039 shall guide the actions of the college in developing and delivering educational and training programs throughout the district, based on emerging and measurable need.
