Purpose/Principle/Definitions:

Students with exceptional academic accomplishment may graduate with Honors or High Honors designation in the BMCC Commencement program and on their official transcript.

Guidelines:

Students must have attended BMCC at least two terms and have earned at least 24 credits from BMCC towards their stated degree intent.

- **Honors:** Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.54-3.74 in all courses taken that meet their chosen degree or certificate requirements as of the end of the term prior to the term they graduate.
- **High Honors**: Student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.75 or 4.0 in all courses taken that meet their chosen degree or certificate requirements as of the end of the term prior to the term they graduate.

Note: Only BMCC courses/credits and grades will be factored into the cumulative GPA for Honors or High Honors designation.
