Purpose/Principle/Definitions:

It shall be a violation of college policy for a student to possess, consume, be perceptibly under the influence of, or furnish alcoholic beverages (as identified by federal or state law) on college-owned or -controlled property or at functions supervised by the college or student organizations, except as approved by the President.

It shall be a violation of college procedure for a student to possess, consume, be perceptibly under the influence of, or furnish any narcotic or dangerous drug, as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes, on college-owned or -controlled property or at functions supervised by the college or student organizations, except when use or possession is lawfully prescribed.

It shall be a violation of college policy for a student to possess, sell, or deliver drug paraphernalia, defined by Oregon Revised Statues, on college-owned or -controlled property or at functions supervised by the college or student organizations, except when possession is lawfully prescribed.

Sanctions that may be imposed for violating college procedure include: (1) disciplinary admonition and warning; (2) disciplinary probation with specific terms for continued enrollment, and suspension or expulsion for violation of those terms; (3) suspension for a definite period of time; and (4) expulsion (removal of privilege to attend the college). Parents of students under 16 years of age will be notified.

Students in violation of this policy may be referred to the AVP, Enrollment Management for appropriate action under the code of student conduct.
