Purpose/Principle/Definitions:

College classes are designed for adult learners with instructional content that consists of adult topics. By enrolling in BMCC classes, minors and their legal guardians acknowledge that this is the environment in which the minor student will learn.

All students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with adult environments and BMCC Student Rights, Responsibilities, and Conduct Standards. Should a student be disruptive, the instructor has the right and responsibility to address the disruption in the classroom, which may include removal of the student with consequences such as permanent dismissal from class without refund of tuition, books, or fees and may affect the student's grade.

The College and its students are subject to federal FERPA (Family Education and Rights to Privacy Act) rules and, therefore, parents and others are not entitled to information on students' attendance, performance, or other academic information without the express written consent from the student, and as outlined in BMCC's Rights to Privacy procedure (#07-2003-0016) and the Student Handbook.
